Dear Parents/ Caregivers,

The Jungle Team classes have planned a trip to Kelly Tarlton's Sea World as part of our Inquiry into the big question "What is Worth Saving?". Our learning will be centred around an in- depth study of 'The Ocean'.

We will travel by bus to the venue. Children and parents accompanying us will need to be in the school hall by 8.00 am for roll call and a safety briefing.

Children will need to bring the following clothing on the trip:

- Full school uniform – including polar fleece.
- Jacket (if the weather is wet)
- Closed in shoes or sandals with a strap. (Health and Safety requirements).

Children will also need to bring the following food and drink on the trip:

- Large morning tea snack
- Lunch (sandwiches and fruit)
- Large plastic drink bottle of water (or 2 smaller bottles)

The cost of the trip will be \$10 per child. A huge thank-you to PTA for their donation to help keep the cost to \$10, we are so grateful for their support.

Proposed Programme

8.00 - All children and parent helpers to meet in the hall for roll call and safety briefing

8.30 - Bus departs for Kelly Tarlton's Sea World

9.30 - Arrive at Kelly Tarlton's Sea World - Morning Tea (large)

10.00 am - 12.00 noon – Two one hour sessions

1. Parent supervised tour of venue

2. Activities with venue educator

12- 12.30 - Gather together and have lunch (in a designated area).

12.30 pm - Bus departs for Karaka School

1.30 pm - Arrive back at school (dependent on traffic)
