Schedule of Events

8.00 am	Bacon and Egg rolls and coffee available for breakfast. Also Café items
8.30am	Children with animals to collect their numbers from the cabin. <u>Each child needs to register their animal and collect their entry number in good time before judging starts, from the cabin on the bottom flat. When your child has finished please return your entry number back to the cabin to be in to win a prize.</u>
9.00am	Stalls Open Judging of ponies, piglets, lambs, goats and chickens commences
10.00am	Blokes Baking to Hall to be judged by a mystery judge
11.00am	Judging takes place of Blokes Baking
11.00am – 12.00pm	Classrooms open for viewing arts and crafts projects. Classrooms are unable to be opened the entire day for security reasons. If you have been involved with animals and miss this time, please locate your child's teacher and they will be happy to open up for you.
12.00pm	Quick Fire Raffles , Blokes Baking competition results
12.30pm	Auction
1.30pm	Prize Giving, Raffles Drawn, Boot Bingo Draw for Tablet – Animal Entries

It is very hard to give an exact time for the judging of each event, so please try to use discretion by following the guidelines above. It is always important to be nearby or listening as sometimes children are called back for different reasons e.g. lead off.

If for any reason you need to withdraw your animal from judging please notify the office urgently, programmes will be printed Friday.

Photos of all children with their animals will be taken during the day (for the photo certificates) – PLEASE watch out for the photographer and ensure that your child has had their photo taken.

Franklin Central Group Day

They do not have to have won a ribbon or championship to be eligible to enter – it is open to any child. Entry forms available at the school office.

Important AG Day Reminders



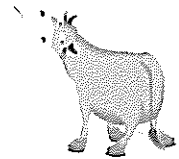
Blokes Baking Competition – Entries must be taken to the hall by 10.00am for judging at 11am. Entry fee \$5.00.

Produce / Flowers / Plants

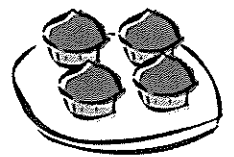

... and the list goes on - So don't be shy on Saturday to have a bid and help raise lots of \$'s for our school - you may even get a bargain!!

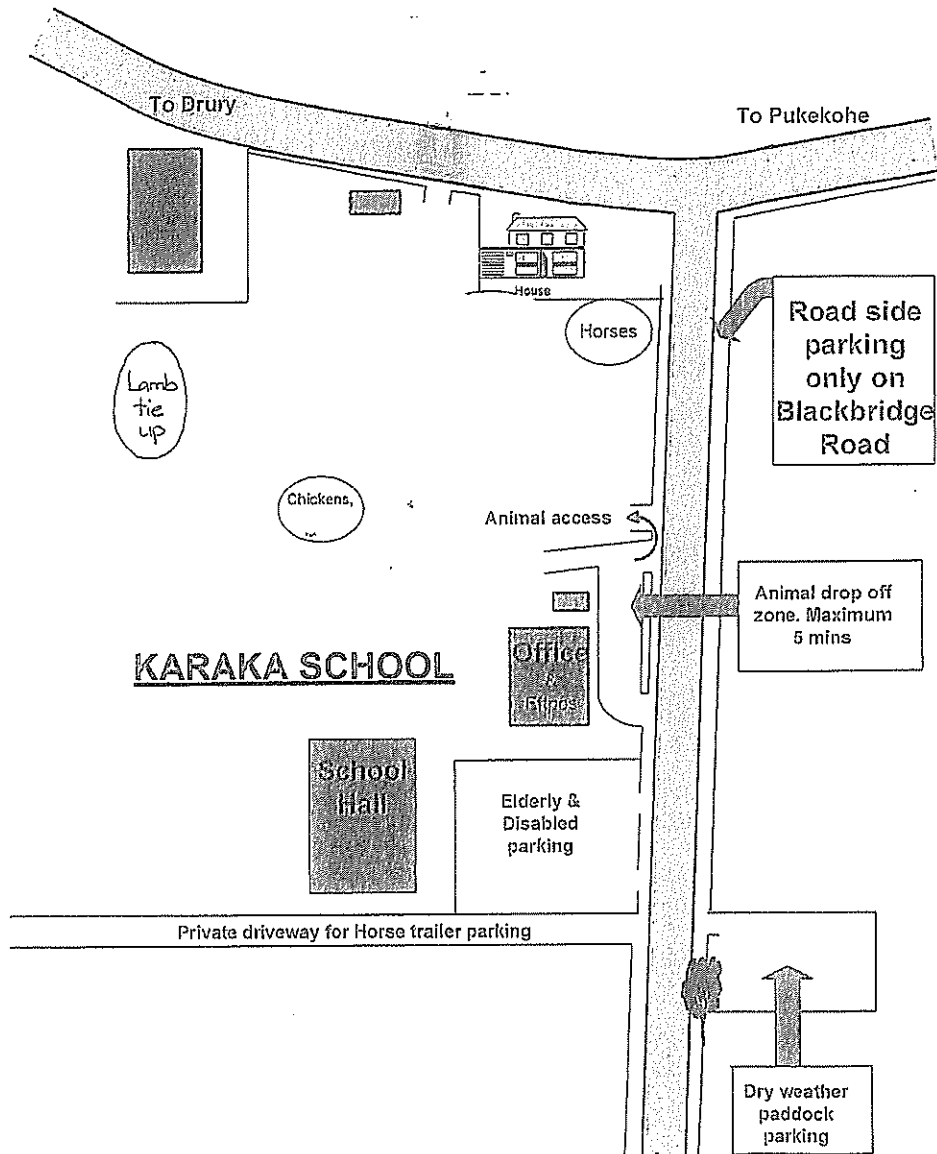

CASHLESS TICKETS - ALL FOOD AND ACTIVITIES

All children's activities and food this year will be run using a cashless ticket system. With the exception of the coffee carts and donuts who are outside providers and will take both cash and cashless tickets.

Tickets will be sold in \$1 and \$2 values.

We will also have the option of a \$5 or \$10 purchase of cashless tickets made up from the \$1 & \$2 tickets.

The \$5 option will be 2x \$2 tickets + 1x \$1 ticket that will be stapled together to make the \$5 so then this can be used as \$5 or pulled apart to use separately depending on costs of the activity or stall.

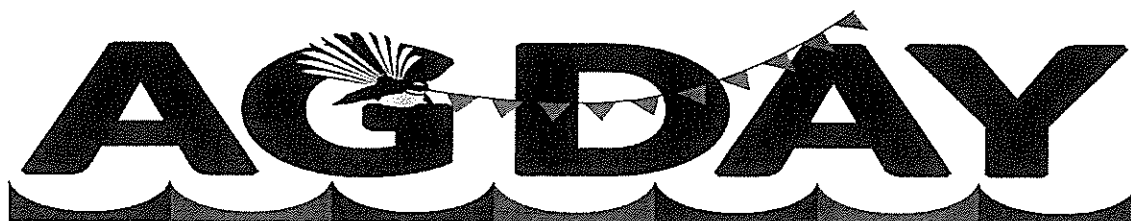
The \$10 option will be 5x \$2 tickets stapled together to make \$10.

The amount of cashless tickets you purchase is up to you. An order form will be sent out next week so if you would like to avoid the queues on AG day to purchase tickets you will be able to pre-order and pay for the amount of cashless tickets you require before AG Day. These orders will then be collated and placed in envelopes with your name on to be collected on AG Day.

Cashless ticket sales will also be available on the day from the Office. You will be able to pay with EFTPOS or cash for your cashless ticket purchases.

EFTPOS will still be available to pay for any auction items or if you prefer you can pay with cash for auction items ONLY.

It is important you use all the tickets you have purchased as there will be NO REFUNDS for unused tickets.
