As you are no doubt aware from recent media articles and social media content, the Teachers Union has planned a one day strike on **Monday 12th November 2018.** The Board of Trustees is very conscious of not wanting to cause hardship to families arising out of this strike action, but at the same time is supportive of sending a strong message to the Government about the current severe shortage of teachers, and the lack of incentive to become a teacher. Without attracting passionate teachers who are dedicated to the profession, and appropriately remunerating them, the quality of education for our future children is at risk. The Board of Trustees have therefore agreed to close the school on this day.
