Online Safety:

This morning we received an advisory from the Director of Education - Auckland, regarding the harmful content that was shared on Tik Tok. The Ministry funds an organisation called Netsafe which supports schools with online safety and security. If your child has access to Tik Tok or other social networking sites and therefore may have been exposed to the distressing content, Netsafe have advised the following:

We recommend that children are being made aware not to share or view the footage as it can be highly distressing content. Our webpage has information about helping tamariki exposed to upsetting content that you may find useful. We have also provided some support lines should they need to reach out for support below.

This content can have an impact beyond those who immediately engage with it. It is likely to have had a range of impacts on each person – some may be severely affected and others may not be affected at all. It is important to be aware of the need to talk with young people who have heard about it and to encourage them to express their feelings in response to the video. We recommend that having regular, open conversations at home around online safety is important to help young people navigate the myriad of digital challenges they will experience.


