### **CAR PARKING**

PLEASE take care when using our school car park and our drop off/pick up bay.

DO NOT PARK IN THE 'NO PARKING' AREAS WHEN DROPPING OFF OR COLLECTING YOUR CHILD FROM SCHOOL OR ON THE YELLOW LINES INSIDE THE CARPARK AND OUTSIDE ON THE ROAD.

This is causing traffic jams and making it dangerous for others.

The most important rule is to use your common sense. Please do not leave your car in the bus bay or drop off area! Cars parked here, should have drivers in them at all times! Our buses do not always arrive at the same time.

Remember this is a "pick up and drop off area" only.

ALSO please remember to use the crossing in the middle of the carpark. DO NOT walk your children across the carpark behind cars as this is a safety issue.

#### **MEDICINE**

Please be aware that all medication administered to a child must be brought to the office in the first instance.

Medication MUST NOT be taken to the classroom or put in your child's lunchbox.
