Important Updates:

This Thursday we expect to hear what the new Alert Level 2 will look like. Following this announcement the Ministry of Education will provide more specific guidelines for schools. We will then begin to plan for this move so that should the Prime Minister announce the move to Level 2 on Monday, we will be prepared. Below is a timeline based on the information we currently have at hand.

OR Continue with distance learning should we remain at Level 3. | Please check your emails for any correspondence from us and respond as asked as soon as possible. |
| Tuesday 12 May MoE will update schools with any new information as a result of the Prime Minister's announcement | Read any new information. Communicate relevant information to our school families. | Should we be moving to Level 2, you will be asked to confirm your attendance. Please do this as soon as possible so we can be well prepared. |
