The sunshine also proved helpful last Friday when we carried out our fire drill after lunch as our shoes didn't end up a muddy mess down on the bottom flat. I hope your children passed on how proud I was of them all after the fire drill for some of our youngest learners it was their very first practice, and they were amazing.

## Shopping

Personalised payment requests will appear on the home page under your student's name. Pay the full amount by clicking 'add to cart' next to the item or make a part payment, by changing the amount in the white boxes before clicking 'add to cart' (if available).


**Shop items:** click on these optional items and add them to your cart.

Once you have made all your purchases, click on the Checkout option to go to the payment section. You will have the opportunity to pay/part pay, any outstanding fees or donations and add them to your cart.



Review your cart, remove any unwanted items then simply click **complete order** at the checkout and you're done! If you have insufficient funds, you will be able to top up your account before completing your purchases.

Your order will automatically go through to the school, and you will receive an email receipt confirming your top up and/or purchase!

# <u>Linwood Road, Blackbridge Rd and Dyke Road intersection Safety</u> upgrade.

This letter is to inform you that Linwood Rd, Blackbridge Rd and Dyke Rd intersection will undergo a safety upgrade as part of the Development of the Karaka Village area. The intersection layout will change to a roundabout upon completion of these works.

#### Work scope

The scope of works for the intersection works is listed below.:

- · Road layout change including installation of new roundabout.
- As part of the intersection layout change, the following will be upgraded kerb and channel, some footpath works, drainage works, pavement works, roadmarking and signage.
- . A copy of what the completed intersection will look like is shown on the other side of this letter.

#### Work timeframes

Construction work will start early September 2023 and continue until end of November 2023. Duration may get extended due to weather and any unforeseen circumstances.

Standard works hours will be 7.30am to 5pm Mon to Sat and night works between 7pm to 5am.

#### Traffic Management

- Temporary traffic management will be in place through out the duration off the works. Please follow all posted signages.
- . We would advise you to park your vehicles within your property or away from the work site area.
- The work involves heavy machinery, which can be noisy. We will, however, use industry best practice to keep this to a minimum.
- For your safety, please keep young children and animals supervised and clear of work areas.
