Property Update:

Now that we are heading into what is really beginning to feel like summer (finally!), we have put together a schedule for use of the school pool for the remainder of Term 4. It seems a timely reminder for me to update you on the pool maintenance plans for the January holiday period. Those of you that have seen the pool recently will know that the exterior is in dire need of some TLC (I'm pretty sure it's four different layers of paint I can see in the sections that have now peeled away to expose the bare concrete underneath...). Upon closer inspection, we have also discovered a couple of cracks under some of the interior tiles on the pool sides; in time these will cause a slow, yet steady leak.

For a bit of background knowledge, the Ministry will not provide any money for schools towards the maintenance of school pools. The main reason for this comes down to inequity as not all schools have pools (and no new schools will have a pool built from now on), therefore they deem it an unfair allocation of crown funds. But not to fear - our fantastic Board has supported and approved the upgrade to ensure our pool is up to spec and will survive many more years of enjoyment in the summer months. The best news is that all of this work will take place over the Christmas holiday period, so when we return to school for 2024 our students will have a school pool that looks 'brand new'!! Come the middle of February you might even find me tempted to get in and join the kids lol!
